Guidance for those undertaking the course

The best way to study this course is with the help of an appointed person from a local church. It is suggested that you first go through each study on your own and then with the appointed person so that they can help you to understand what you have read and answer your questions. They will be there to help you and be a friend to you at the beginning of your Christian life. It is also possible to do this study course as part of a small group or on your own.

As you do the course expect God to speak to you and tell you more about Himself. Pray (or talk) with God before you begin each study. Ask His help to understand what you are reading and look for things you need to apply to your life. Do not hurry through the studies. If you are doing them with another person then work out times that are mutually convenient to meet and set your pace together. A group will set its own times. If you are doing the studies alone then do not attempt more than one study per day (the exception to this is studies 1 and 2 which may be done together).

The Bible references are written in short-hand, for example with *1 John 2:3*

If more than one verse is referred to, read from the first verse mentioned through to the last one, e.g. – 1-3 means read verses 1, 2 and 3.
